Registration Classification

Our District Conference is open to all Alliance Church members and adherents, and all people attending are expected to register. Registrants are classified as (1) *Accredited Delegates with voting privileges*, and (2) *Corresponding Delegates with no-voting privileges*. All licensed Workers and Officially-Appointed-Lay-Delegates from churches, and those involved in other recognized District Committees and Auxiliary Supported Ministries are eligible to register as *Accredited*; All other Conference attendees must register as *Corresponding*.

Registration Information

ONLINE Regular Registration runs from June 1st through August 31st, 2024. The Accredited or Corresponding delegate that attends **at least 2-3 days of Conference is \$94**. This includes the Banquet Dinner on Monday and the Luncheons on Tuesday for men and women respectively. A discounted cost for Retired Workers which has the same inclusion is **\$74**. The cost for those who wish to attend the conference for **one day only is \$53 without meals**. Separate costs that can be “add-on” to your registration are made available such as: Banquet only for \$16; Luncheon only for \$24; and RMN Chemistry Building Activity to a Ranger’s Game with a dinner buffet **for only \$25** (of the total cost of \$47) per delegate. The difference in the total cost to the Ranger’s Game per person ($\$47 - \$25 = \$22$) will be covered by the district.
